

Michael A. Mazza – Chief Executive Officer



Michael A. Mazza is Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Middlesex Hospital Alliance, a position he has held since 1999. The Alliance is a partnership of Strathroy Middlesex General Hospital and Four Counties Health Services in Newbury. Mr. Mazza came to the Alliance from his position as CEO of Four Counties Health Services.

From 2001 to 2005 Mr. Mazza was on the Board of Directors of the Ontario Hospital Association and served on a number of committees including Human Resources and Finance and Audit. Mr. Mazza has also served as Chair of OHA Region 5 and participated in a number of local initiatives in the region. Currently, he is a member of the OHA Medium-sized Hospital Provincial Leadership Council.

Prior to coming to Middlesex County, Mr. Mazza was Executive Director of Centre Grey General Hospital in Markdale where he was a key player in establishing a five-hospital merger of Northern Grey and Bruce Counties hospitals. The merged hospitals are now known as Grey Bruce Health Services. While in Markdale, Mr. Mazza was on the Hospital Operations Committee and the IT Committee of the Grey Bruce District Health Council (DHC), was a member of the Program Advisory Committee for Georgian College and a Rotarian.

Before that, Mr. Mazza was part of the senior management team of St. Joseph's Hospital in North Bay. He co-chaired the North Bay Paediatrics Committee and taught part-time at Nipissing University and Canadore College.

Mr. Mazza is a member of the Executive Committee of the Thames Valley Hospital Planning Partnership and was active on the Middlesex County Health System Planning Committee of the now defunct Thames Valley District Health Council. He holds a Master's of Public Administration Degree from Queen's University and is a member of the Canadian College of Health Service Executives.
