Caradoc Sands Golf Club Hosts 17th Strathroy Rotary Golf Tournament

The Rotary Club of Strathroy is pleased to announce one of the area's biggest golfing tournaments of the year, the 17th Annual Strathroy Rotary Open Golf Tournament. The tournament will begin with a shot gun start at 12:00 noon on Saturday May 26 at Caradoc Sands Golf Course. Proceeds from the day will be donated to the Strathroy Hospital CT Scanner campaign.

Players in this year's tournament will be competing for two hole in one prizes: two tickets to fly anywhere in North America (some conditions apply), or a 24 Month pre-paid lease of a 2008 Ford Escape. A foursome can be entered for \$300.00 which includes 4 tickets for 18 holes of golf and dinner. An individual can enter for \$75.00, while a spouse is welcome to have dinner for \$25.00.
